# 2021 Cesar Chavez Liderazgo Awards Individual Leader Nomination

The "Cesar Chavez Liderazgo Award" was named in recognition of the Latino Civil Rights Leader, Cesar Chavez, and was established to recognize leaders who build on the foundation of advocacy and make a difference in our community today. Since 2016, we pay tribute to individuals who make significant contributions to their community through their time, actions, talents, and dedication. We recognize individuals who have demonstrated an exemplary level of leadership and community engagement to impact our Latino communities' quality of life positively.

Two finalists will be selected from among the following areas: Business, Nonprofit, Community Leaders, and Young Leaders. The NCL selection committee chooses the finalists. The honorees are recognized at the Annual Cesar Chavez Contemplation Event held in March.

Public Nominations OPEN Wednesday, November 4, 2020, and CLOSE Friday, December 4, 2020, at 5pmEST.

#### Eligibility

Any person can be nominated except for any paid staff or board member of NCL or any member of the Awards committee. Persons nominated for this award will have consistently demonstrated compassion and service to either one organization or various volunteer activities in one year. The charitable activities/events or services listed on the application cannot be part of the nominee's job description or duties. The individual cannot receive any monetary or personal benefits from their involvement.

#### **Selection Process**

The finalists will be chosen by the NCL selection committee comprised of members from the NCL board. Individuals that are nominated are prohibited from serving on the selection committee.

The selection committees will receive all nominees' submission packets in advance to make their final determination on the finalists.

# **Judging Criteria**

1. The degree to which their services/ actions have made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on the Latino community - 40%

- 2. The length and degree of their involvement 20%
- 3. The extent to which their advocacy or action might be considered above and beyond 20%
- 4. The extent to which their action would be recognized and valued by their peers/community leaders- 20%

#### **Length of Service:**

➤ Has the applicant demonstrated sustained commitment to leadership and service?

#### Leadership qualities: Has the applicant:

- Played a role in the creation of a project or non-profit organization
- Effectively mobilized volunteers, partners, and resources to serve the Latino Community

#### Role modeling:

How has the applicant inspired others to engage in community service?

#### Impact on the Latino Community. Innovation:

How has the applicant utilized unique and creative approaches to meeting needs?
